# What is an Automotive Service Excellence certification?

ASE certifications are offered by the National Institute for Automotive Service Excellence (ASE), which is based in the United States and certifies automotive technicians and service professionals.

The ASE offers certifications in more than 50 areas, including:

- Automobile & Light Trucks
- Collision Repair & Refinishing
- Damage Analysis & Estimating
- Automobile Service Consulting
- Truck Equipment
- Alternate Fuels
- Auto Maintenance and Light Repair
- Transit Bus
- Advanced Engine Performance
- Electronic Diesel Engine Diagnosis
- Light Duty Hybrid/Electric Vehicles
- Advanced Driver Assistance Systems (ADAS)
- Parts Specialist

ASE recognized industry standards in the United States and Canada. They demonstrate a technician's competence and expertise in automotive repair and maintenance, and help ensure that vehicle owners receive high-quality maintenance and repairs from trained professionals.

## Who needs an ASE certification?

Organizations that employ automotive technicians, service advisors, and repair professionals often require their employees to have or earn ASE certifications. While not legally mandatory, employees with ASE certifications – as well as the organizations that employ them – are more credible and better equipped to deal with a wide range of industry challenges.

## **How to earn an ASE certification**

Those seeking to earn an ASE certification must pass a discipline-specific test, as well as possess work and/or education experience in the area of certification. Both test content and work experience requirements differ depending on the type of ASE certification. ## **Renewal requirements for ASE certifications**

ASE certifications are valid for five years, after which time certification holders must take a recertification test.
