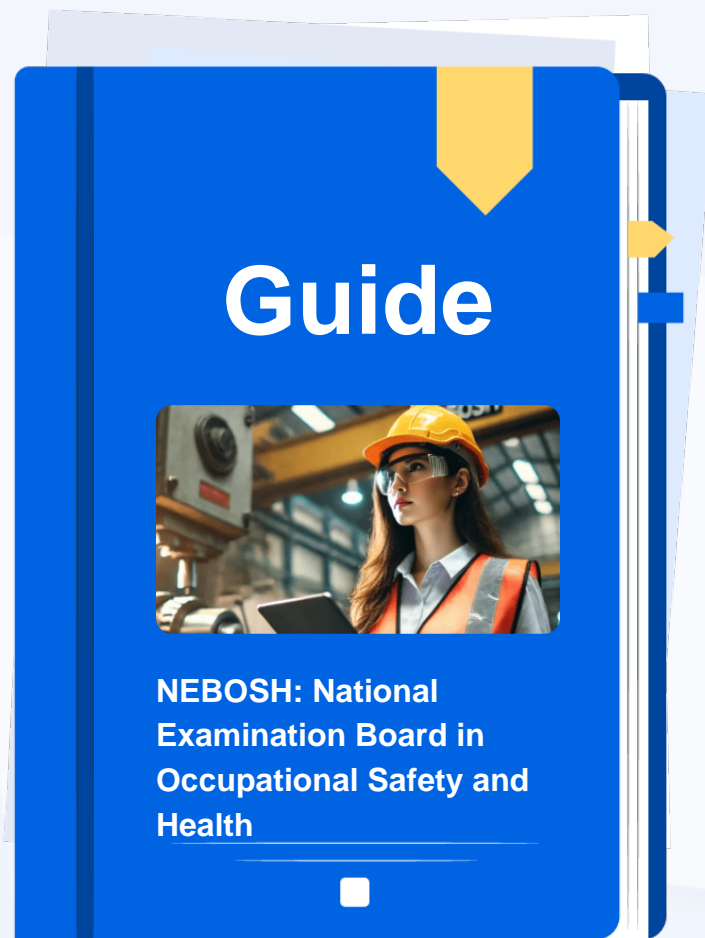

What is NEBOSH?

A NEBOSH – offered by the National Examination Board in Occupational Safety and Health – certification is a globally recognized qualification in health, safety, and environmental management.

There are several types of NEBOSH certifications, ranging from entry-level to advanced, and catered toward different industries and specific safety requirements.

NEBOSH certifications are not mandatory, but they are highly regarded and often preferred for employees who have health, safety, or environmental-facing roles. This means they may be required by certain organizations, even if they are not legally mandatory.

How to earn a NEBOSH certification

The exact steps you'll need to take to earn a NEBOSH certification vary depending on the certification type. Typically, however, candidates must receive classroom training, as well as study on their own.

There are also usually two exams, one on paper (or digital) and one practical. Again, the exact nature of a certification's exam process will depend on the certification itself. Costs also vary depending on certification type, method of study, and examination fees. With this in mind, it is best to check the web page for the specific certification you wish to earn on NEBOSH's website.

NEBOSH certifications have lifetime validity, meaning there is no need to renew or recertify.
